

NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 164)

ORDER MADE BY THE NURSING COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that the Nursing Council of Hong Kong, after due inquiry held on 26 January 2026 in accordance with section 17 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, Chapter 164 of the Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied that Ms. CHEUNG Mei-fong, being an enrolled nurse (Enrolment No. ENG0005555), was guilty of unprofessional conduct, in that during the hospitalisation of Patient X ('the Patient') at the St. Paul's Hospital on 7 October 2020, Ms. CHEUNG:—

- (i) failed to ensure individual safety in the course of practice in that she wrongfully administered to the Patient medications that were prescribed for another patient; and
- (ii) failed to ensure that the standard of practice is congruent with the standards of the profession in that she failed to verify the Patient's identity in accordance with the principles of "Five Rights" before administering medications.

In accordance with section 17 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, the Nursing Council of Hong Kong ordered on 26 January 2026 that the name of Ms. CHEUNG Mei-fong be removed from the roll of enrolled nurses for a period of two months with effect from 21 April 2026, and that such decision be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
