NURSES REGISTRATION ORDINANCE (Chapter 164)

ORDER MADE BY THE NURSING COUNCIL OF HONG KONG

It is hereby notified that the Nursing Council of Hong Kong, after due inquiry held on 16 March 2026 in accordance with section 17 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, Chapter 164, Laws of Hong Kong, was satisfied that Mr. FUNG Kam-hei, being a registered nurse (Registration No. RNGM004352), was convicted of offences punishable with imprisonment, namely:—

- (a) the offence of “Committing an act outraging public decency”, contrary to Common Law, at the Kowloon City Magistrates’ Courts on 29 May 2017; and
- (b) the offence of “Committing an act outraging public decency”, contrary to Common Law, at the Kowloon City Magistrates’ Courts on 23 February 2021.

In accordance with section 17 of the Nurses Registration Ordinance, the Council ordered on 16 March 2026 that the name of Mr. FUNG Kam-hei be removed from the register of nurses for a period of one month with effect from 26 May 2026, and that such decision be published in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Gazette with an account of the proceedings.
